

## Safety and Environmental Requirements for LHU visitors

We encourage all visitors to the LHU mine site to travel by bus. Please book and confirm bus routes and departure/arrival times with your LHU contact. However, if a visitor must drive to the mine site in his/her own vehicle, the following should be noted;

1. Submit your name(s) and car registration number to your LHU site contact.
2. Check your vehicle for road worthiness on a gravel road.
3. Ensure that you have a fire extinguisher, breakdown kit, first aid kit and enough drinking water available in your vehicle.
4. Transporting passengers in the back of a Bakkie is not permitted. All persons to be transported shall have a proper seat and seat belt.
5. Take along minimum Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) if you can. Otherwise it will be provided to you on site. Minimum PPE include a safety/hard hat, safety boots, safety glasses and long pants. The use of Sunscreen is strongly recommended.



6. Wear your seat belt at all times.
7. Be aware of changes in weather and surface road conditions, e.g. fog, wind, air temperatures, dust, and dips in the road.



8. Switch on your vehicles headlights to improve visibility.
9. Do not talk on your mobile phone while driving.



10. **Speed limits** are as follows;
  - a. C28 (main road from Swakopmund) is 100 km/hr, occasionally 80 km/hr,
  - b. Access road is 60 km/hr
  - c. Site roads are 15-20 km/hr.
11. Dust free sections (tarred sections) on the C28 road provide for safe take over. Allow faster moving traffic to pass in these sections.
12. We operate in a national park,
  - a. please do not litter, take your rubbish home
  - b. do not drive off road and make new tracks, stay on existing permanent access roads
  - c. do not disturb wildlife and vegetation
  - d. be wary of wildlife crossing the roads (remember wildlife have right of way)



13. Equipment and materials transported to and from LHU site should be properly secured, covered or tied on to the vehicle to avoid polluting the national park.
14. No drugs, alcohol or weapons are allowed on site.



15. LHU has a zero tolerance policy on alcohol and all visitors will be required to provide a breath sample.
16. If you are visiting for a whole day please bring along your own lunch.
17. In case of an **emergency** contact the following number(s); (Please note that there is limited cellular reception along the entire route).

18. Report any hazards or incidents you may have identified on our roads.
19. Use the reverse parking method on site.
20. Report to the security office upon arrival at site.
21. Obey all traffic rules and regulations on the national road, access and site roads.
22. Once on site all vehicles must “STOP” at the intersection that crosses the haul road and follow the directions of the flagman. “Haul Trucks have right of way.”
