



PARK RULES

The following general permit conditions are applicable when entering the Namib Naukluft Park. These are conditions laid down by the Ministry of Environment and Tourism and must be adhered to at all times.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

It is unlawful to:-

- (a) Drive anywhere other than on a road indicated by a road sign.
- (b) Drive in the Park after sunset or before sunrise, except on proclaimed thoroughfares.
- (c) Leave behind or throw away any smouldering objects.
- (d) Overnight anywhere other than a designated camping site.
- (e) Collect firewood in the park.
- (f) Bring any animal, domestic or otherwise, into the park.
- (g) Throw away bury or leave any refuse behind in any place other than the containers provided.
- (h) Relieve oneself anywhere other than at a sanitary convenience provided.
- (i) Pollute any water or tamper with water installations.
- (j) Make a fire anywhere other than in officially designated fireplaces. Exceptionally large fires are also prohibited.
- (k) Kill, disturb or injure any animal.
- (l) Pick, collect, mutate, uproot or unnecessarily tamper with any plant.
- (m) Mutilate or damage any object in the park.
- (n) Be in possession of an unsealed or loaded firearm.
- (o) Enter any area to which admission is prohibited by means of a notice board.
- (p) Ignore the instructions of a nature conservator.
- (q) Make any undue noise, disturb or inconvenience others.
- (r) Enter the Park with a motorcycle, powered cycle or scooter.
